SASI is a tribal organization of the Navajo Nation which operates the education programs of the Shiprock Associated Schools, Inc., (Navajo Nation), New Mexico, under a grant issued by the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to P.L. 100-297, The Tribally Controlled School Grant Act. The School Board seeks proposals for Kitchen Equipment. Navajo preference will be applied in accordance to Navajo Business Regulatory Act.

Proposals must be submitted no later than **Thursday, December 28, 2023 by 4:00 p.m.** All submittals must contain an original and one (1) copy of the Proposal in a sealed envelope with **"KITCHEN EQUIPMENT RFP"** marked on the front of the envelope.
